





Summary Statement

Monthly and last three months: June 2024/April to June 2024 statement

The rainfall for June and April to June was below normal for Nauru.

Part 1i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for August and August to October 2024

Monthly /Seasonal rainfall and temperature Outlook statements

The rainfall for August is likely to be below normal over Nauru, and near-normal over the southern EEZ. August to October rainfall is very likely to be below normal over Nauru.

Maximum and minimum temperatures during August and average over August to October are very likely to be above normal over Nauru.

Part 2: Recent Ocean summary statement

Monthly and last three months: June 2024/April to June 2024

June ocean temperatures around Nauru were upmost 2.0°C above normal.

Averaged over April to June, ocean temperatures around Nauru were upmost 1.0°C above normal.

June sea levels around Nauru were 50mm to 100mm above normal.

There is a coral bleaching 'Watch' for Nauru.

Part 2i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for August and August to October 2024

Ocean Variable statement

August and averaged over August to October, ocean temperatures around Nauru are predicted to be 0.4 to 1.2°C above normal.

August and averaged over August to October sea levels around Nauru are predicted to be -30mm to 30mm near normal.

Coral bleaching outlook shows 'Alert Level 1' for the next four weeks.

IN BRIEF for Teleconference

- Rainfall was below normal for June and April to June.
- Rainfall is likely or very likely to be below normal in August and August to October.
- SSTs were above normal for June and April to June. The outlook shows above normal SSTs for the next one and three months.
- Sea-surface heights (SSHs) were above normal for June. Near-normal sea surface heights are predicted for August and August to October.
- 4-week coral bleaching outlook is at 'Alert level 1' for majority of Nauru's waters.
