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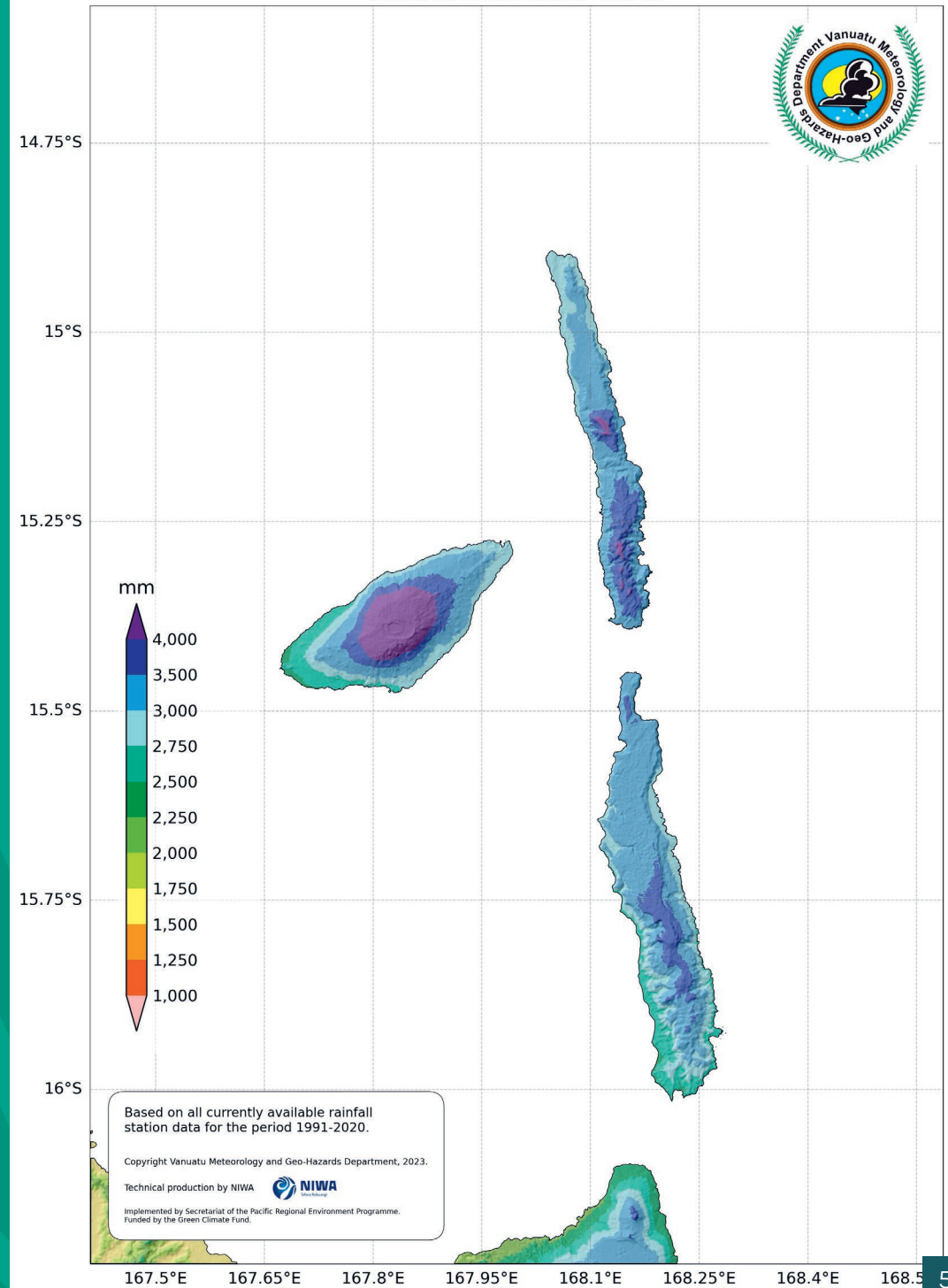

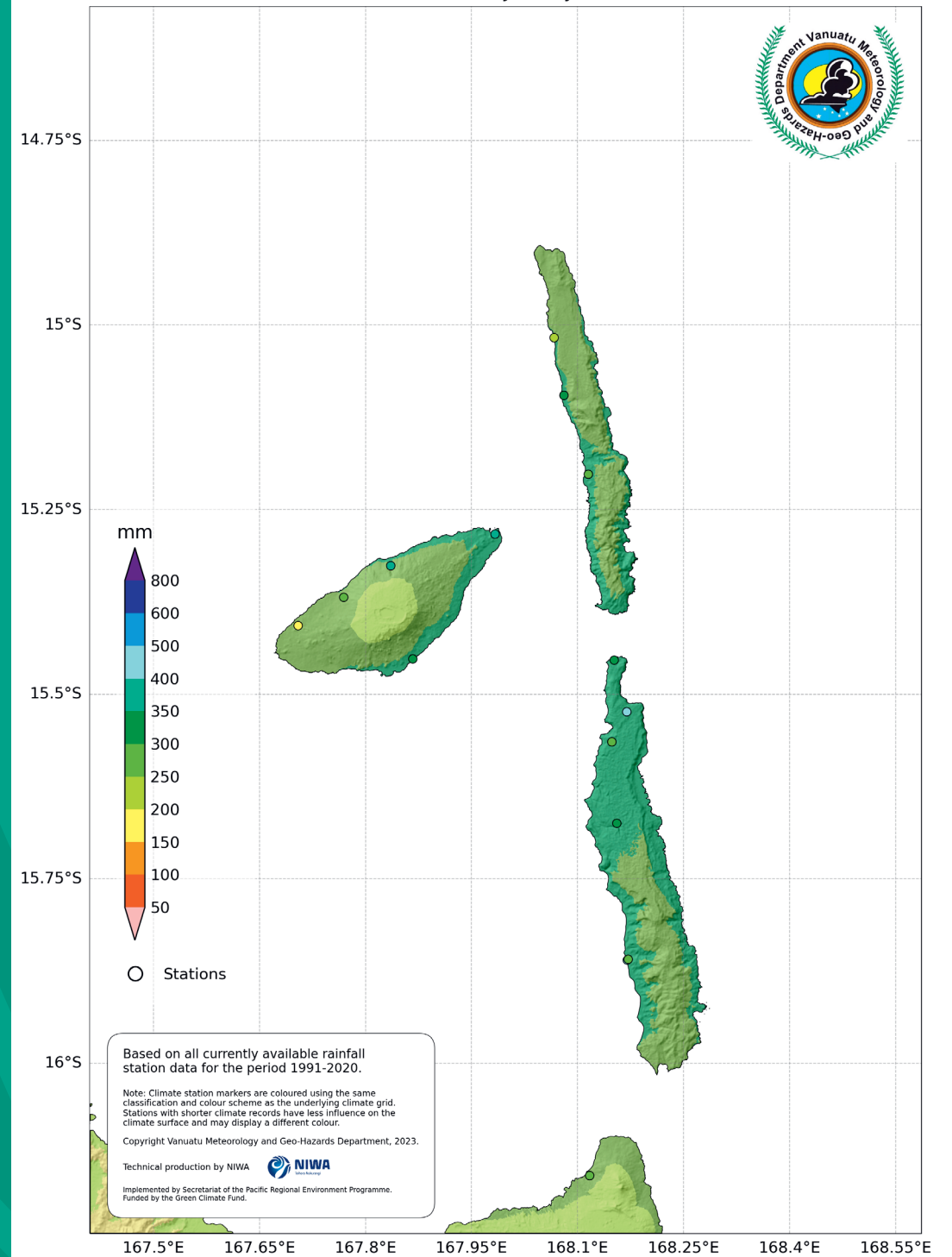
Annual mean rainfall PENAMA

Penama: Mean Annual Rainfall

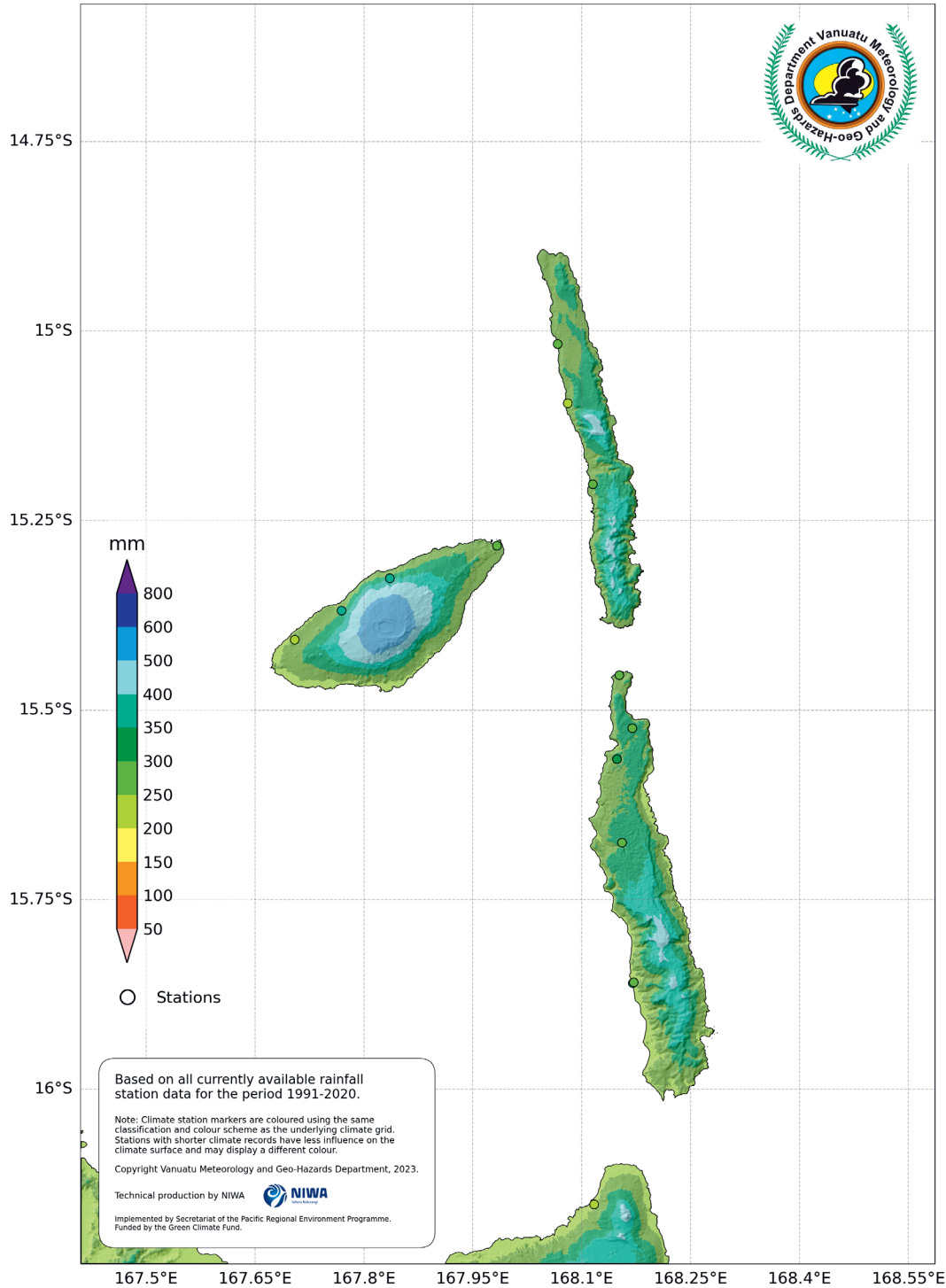


Monthly mean rainfall PENAMA

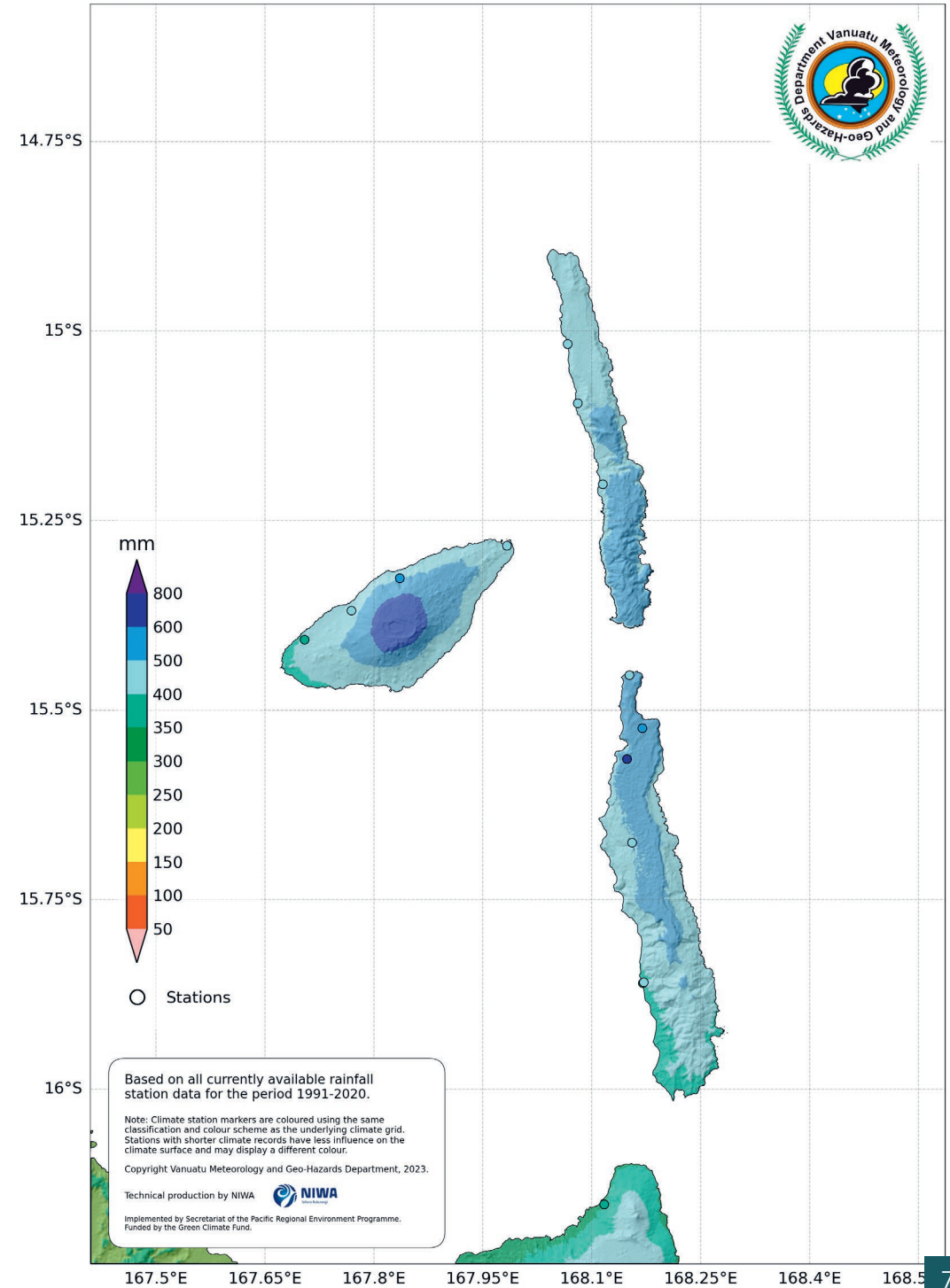

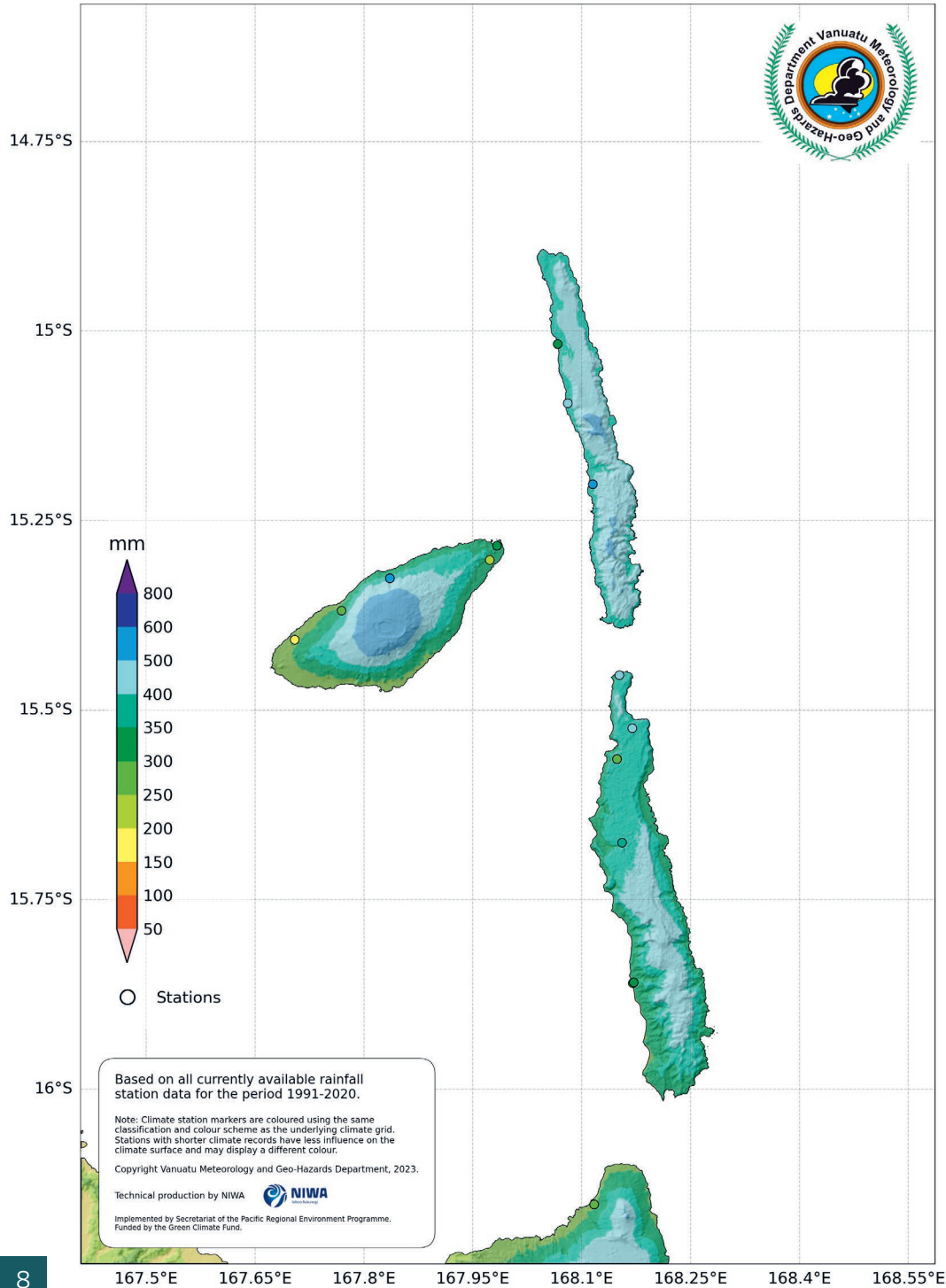

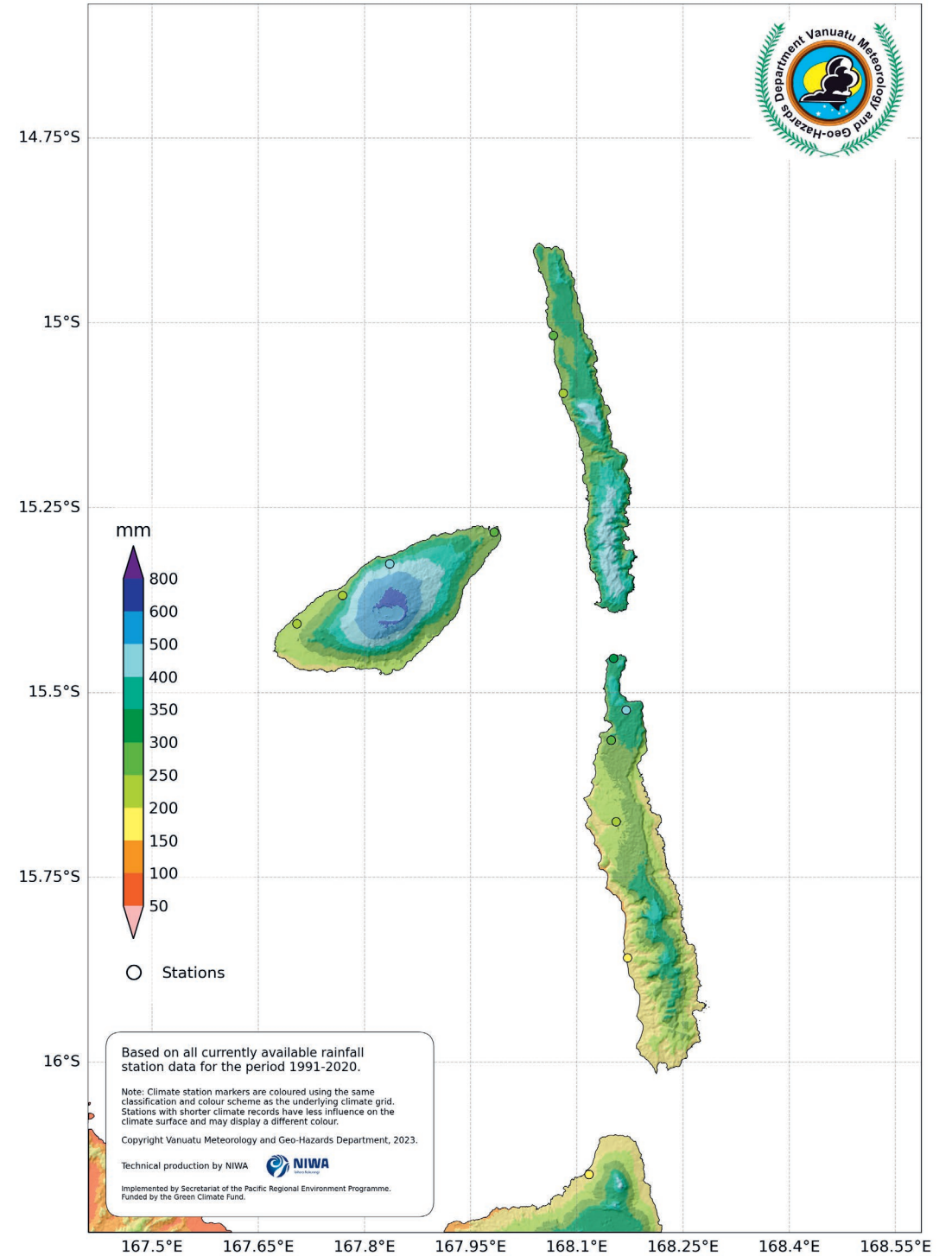

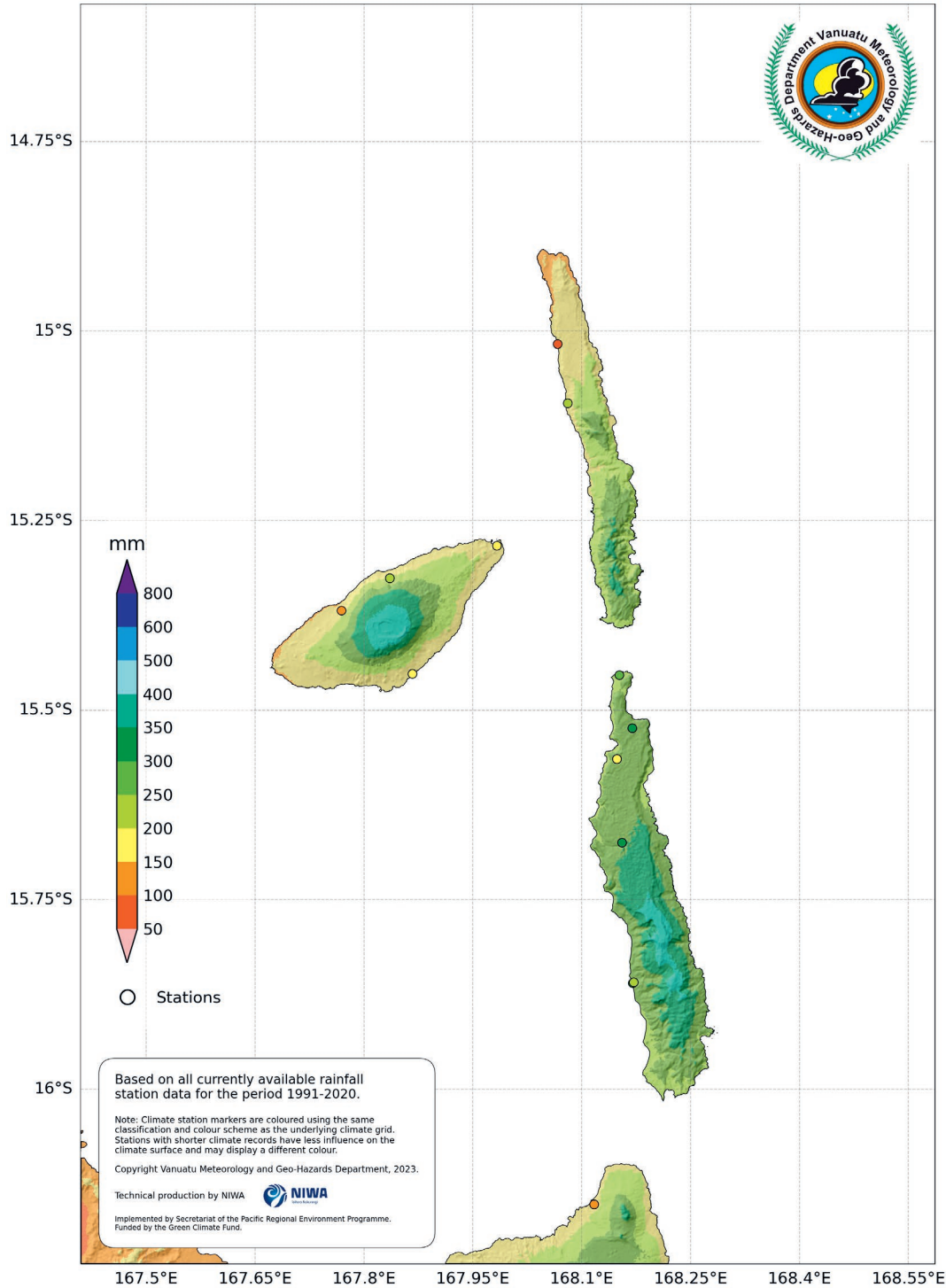

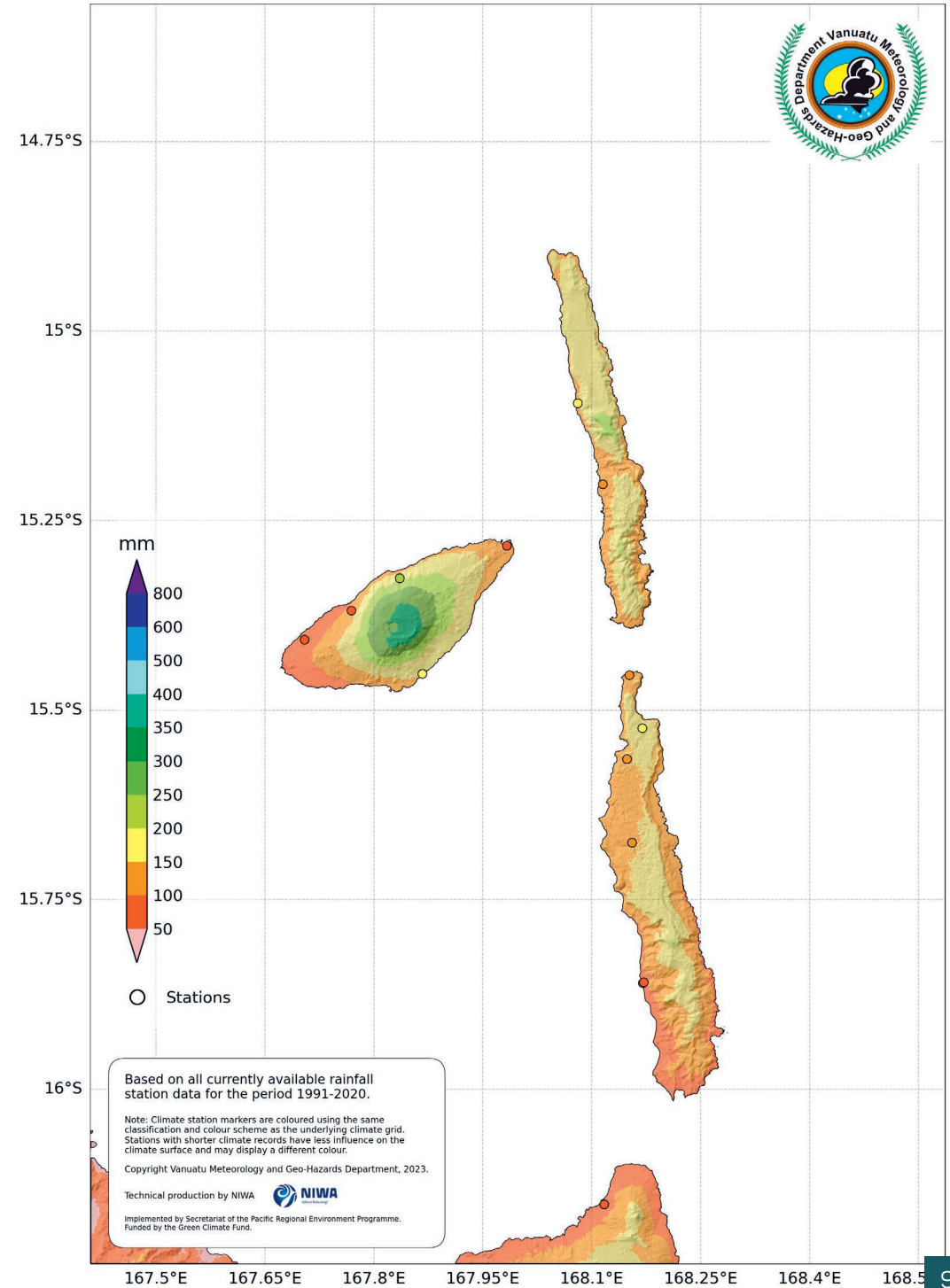

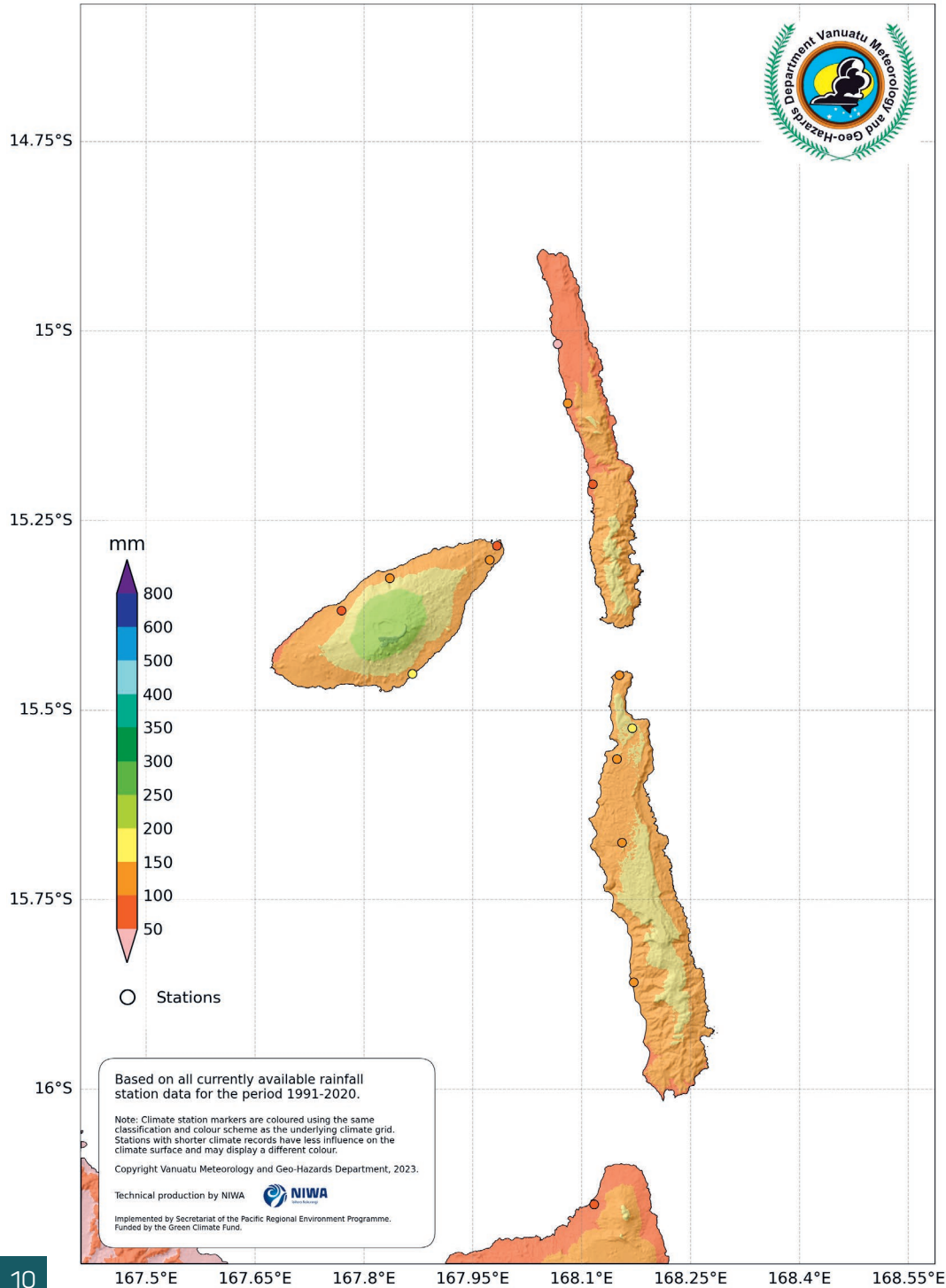

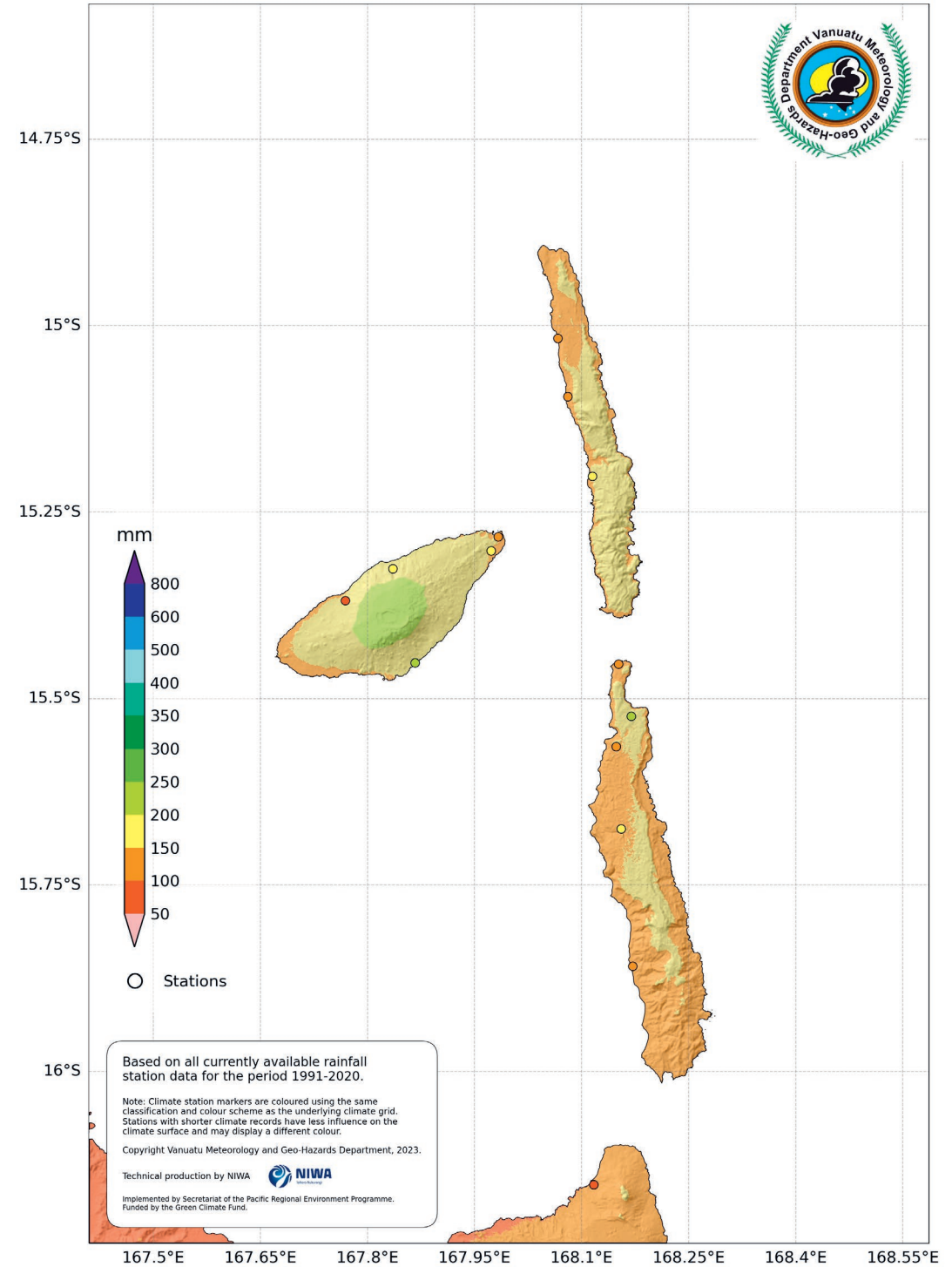

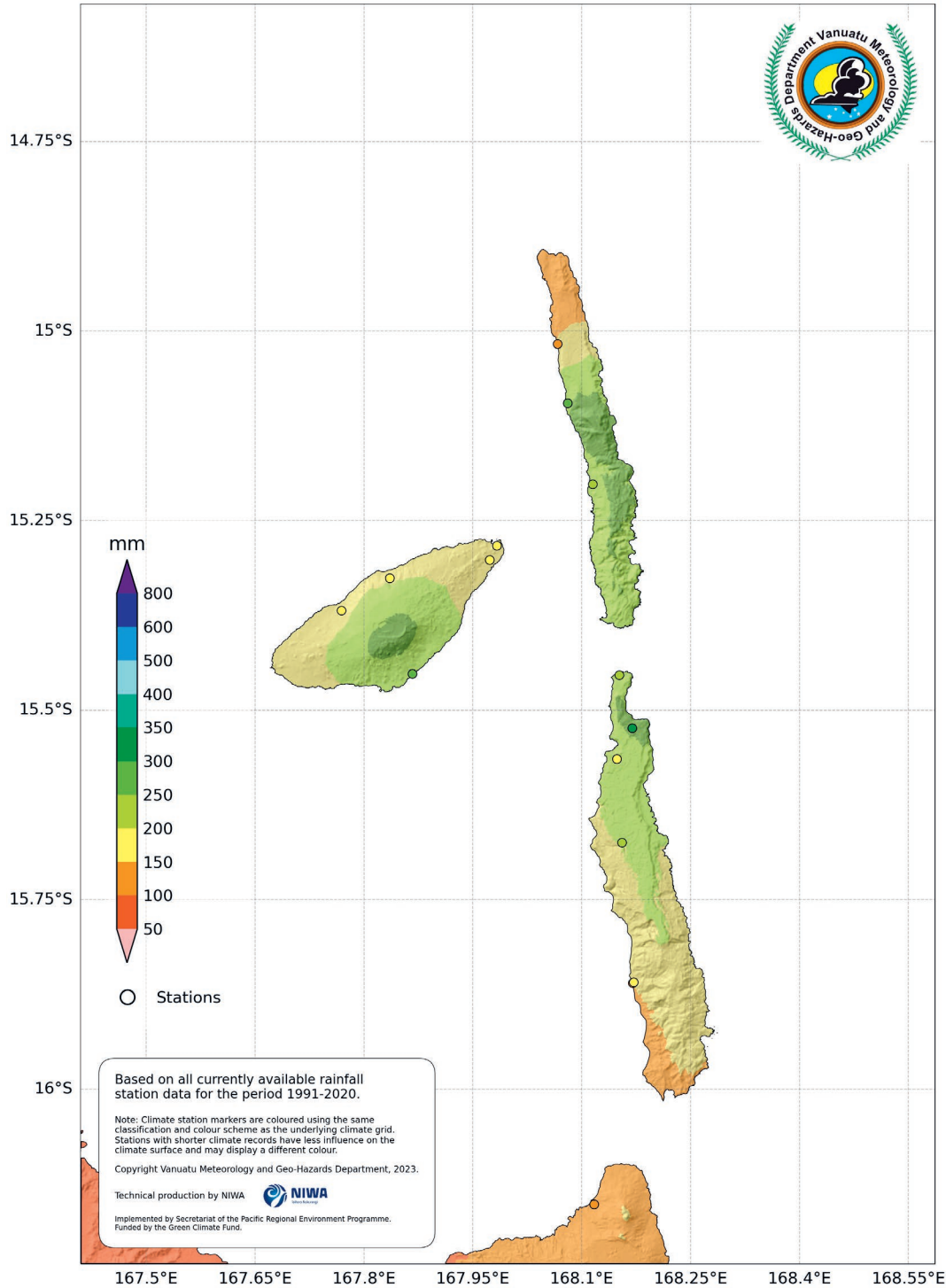

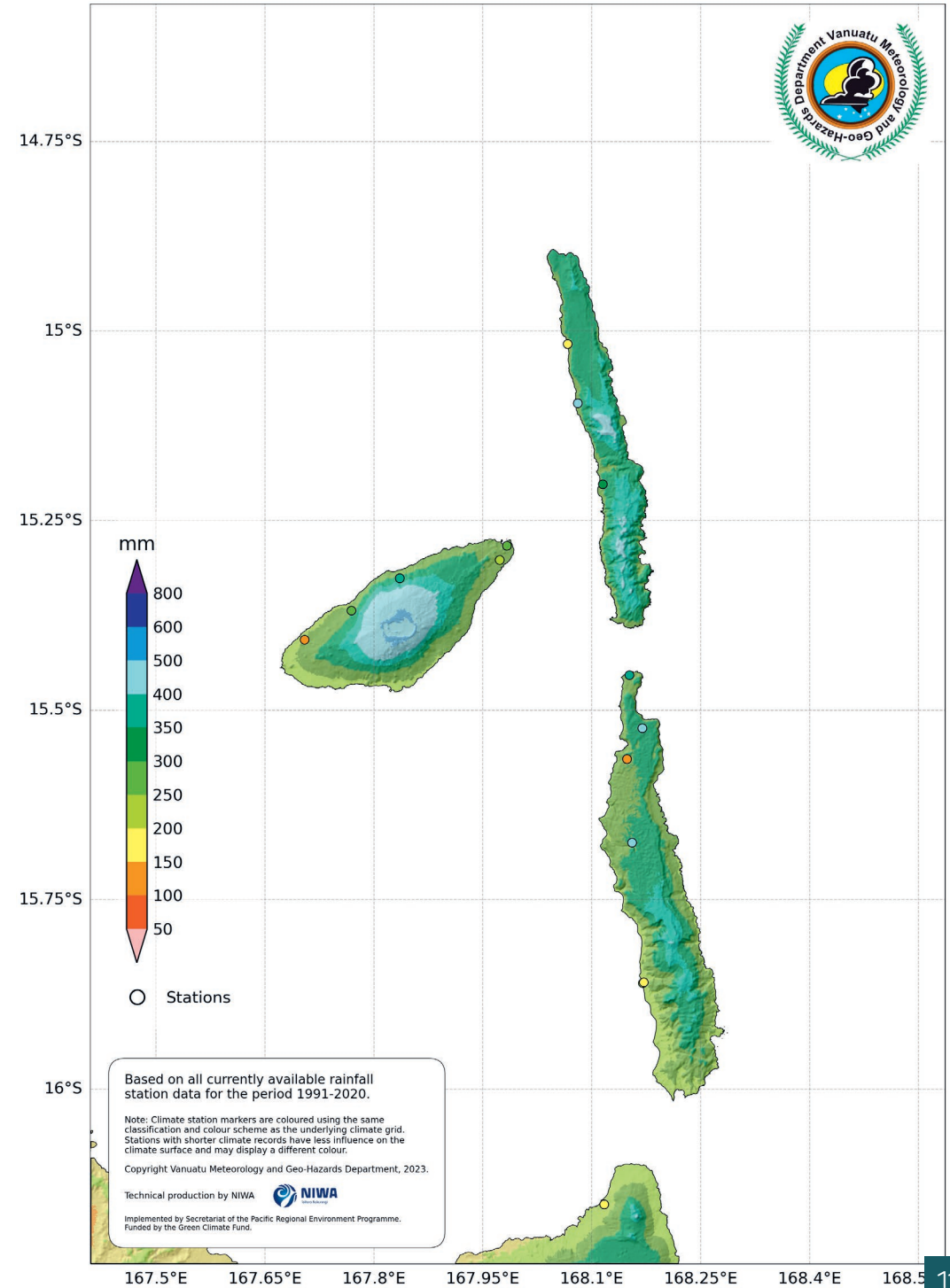

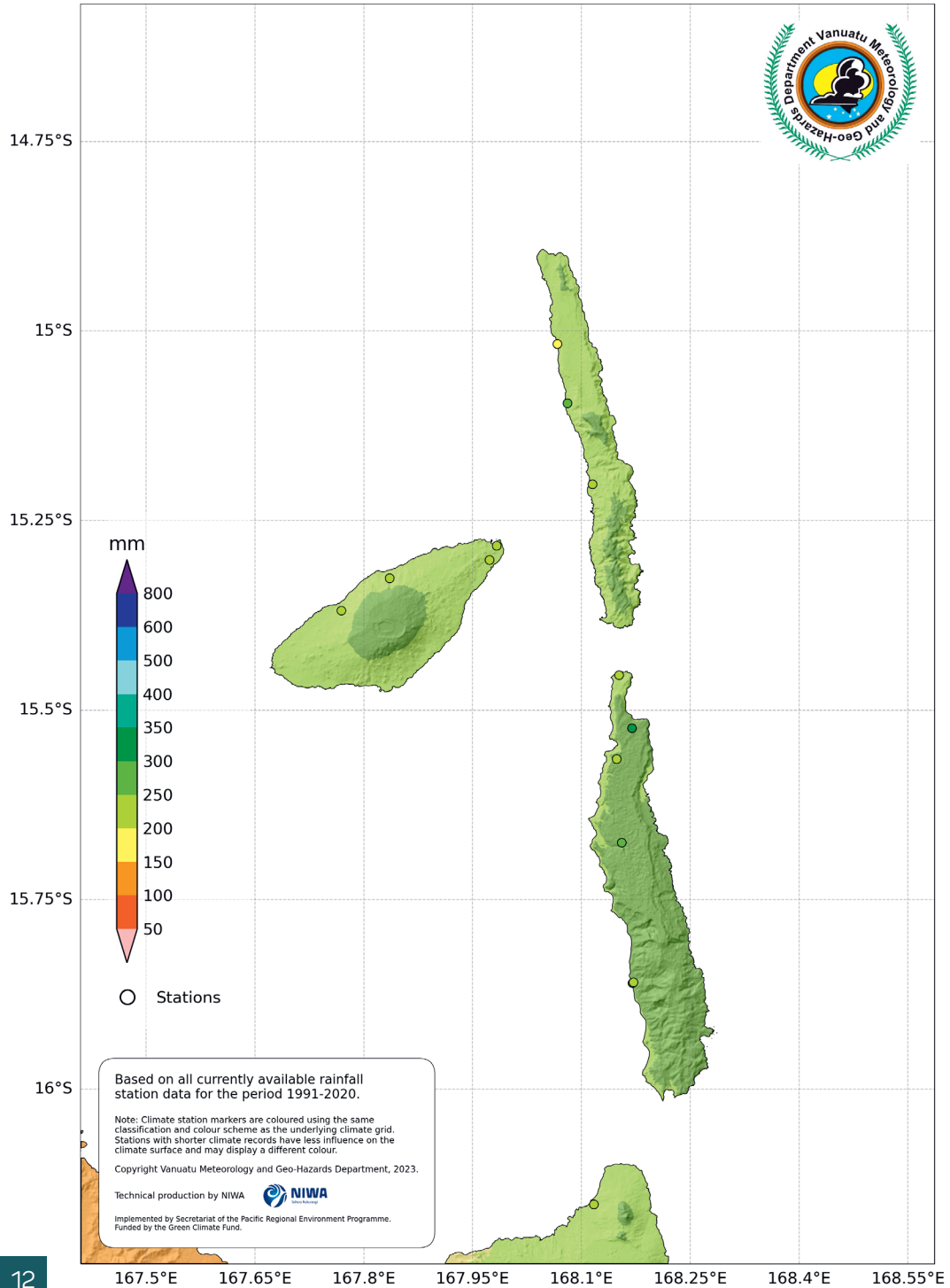

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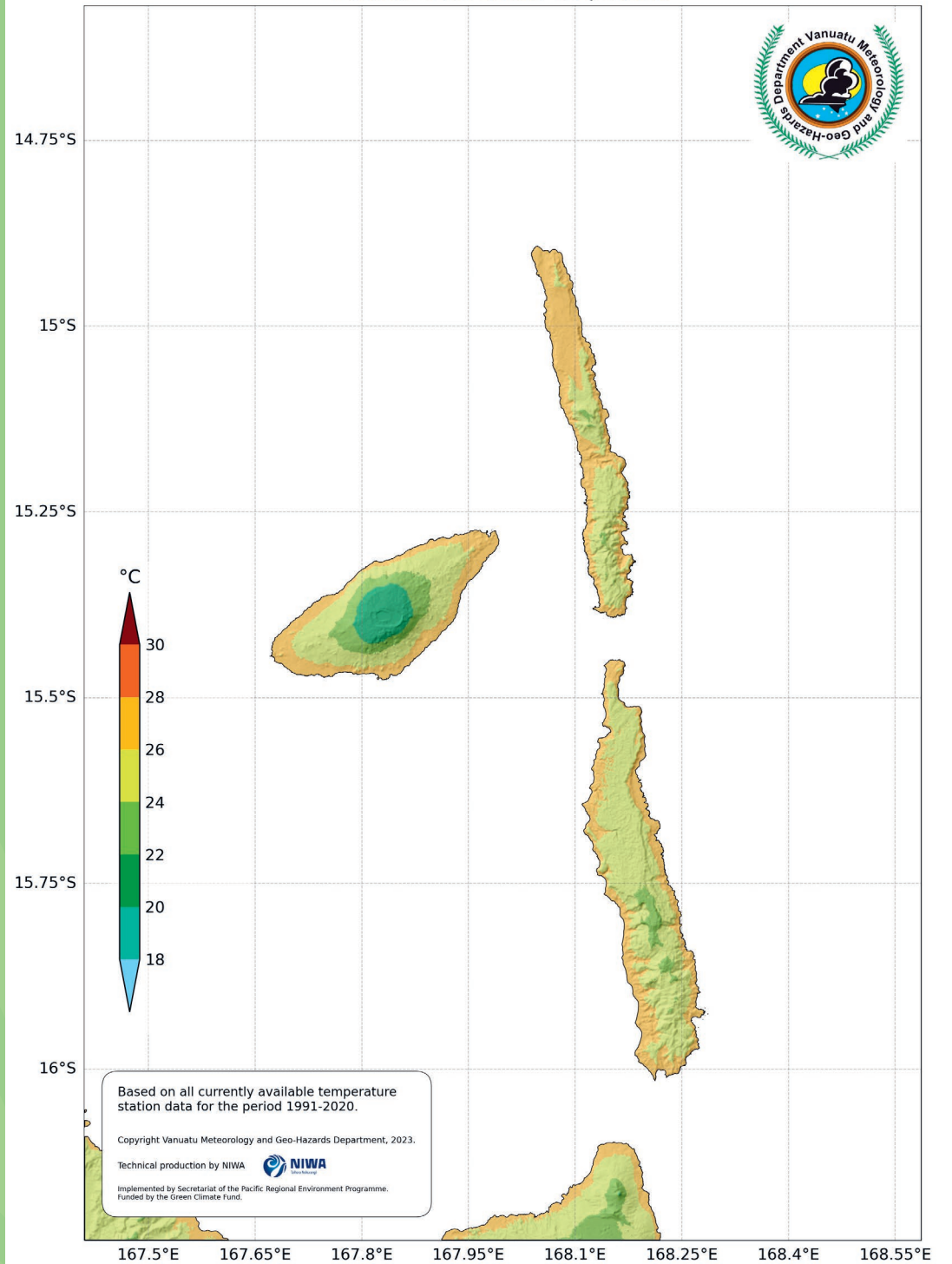

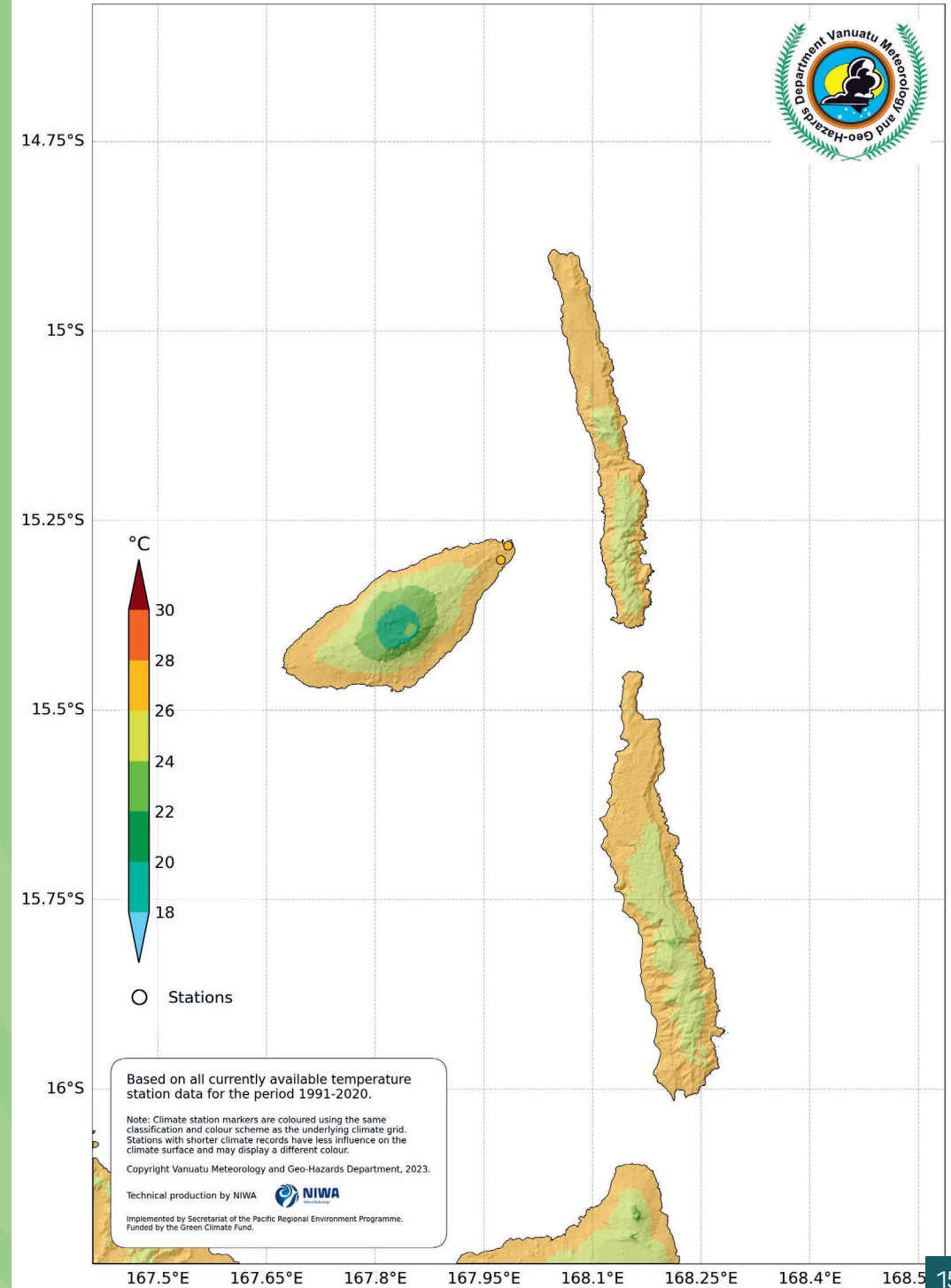
Annual mean temperature PENAMA

Penama: Mean Annual Temperature

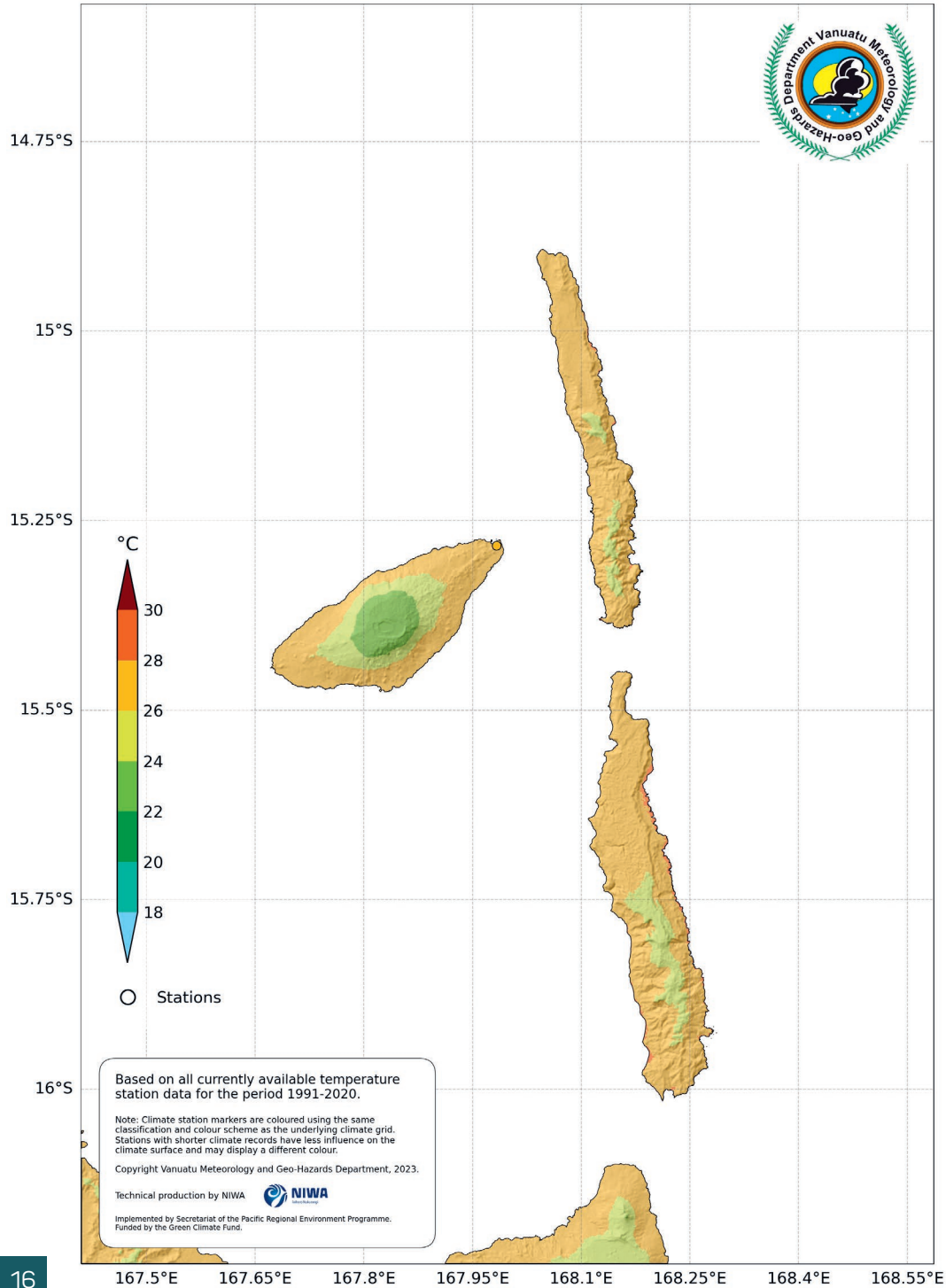


Monthly mean temperatures PENAMA

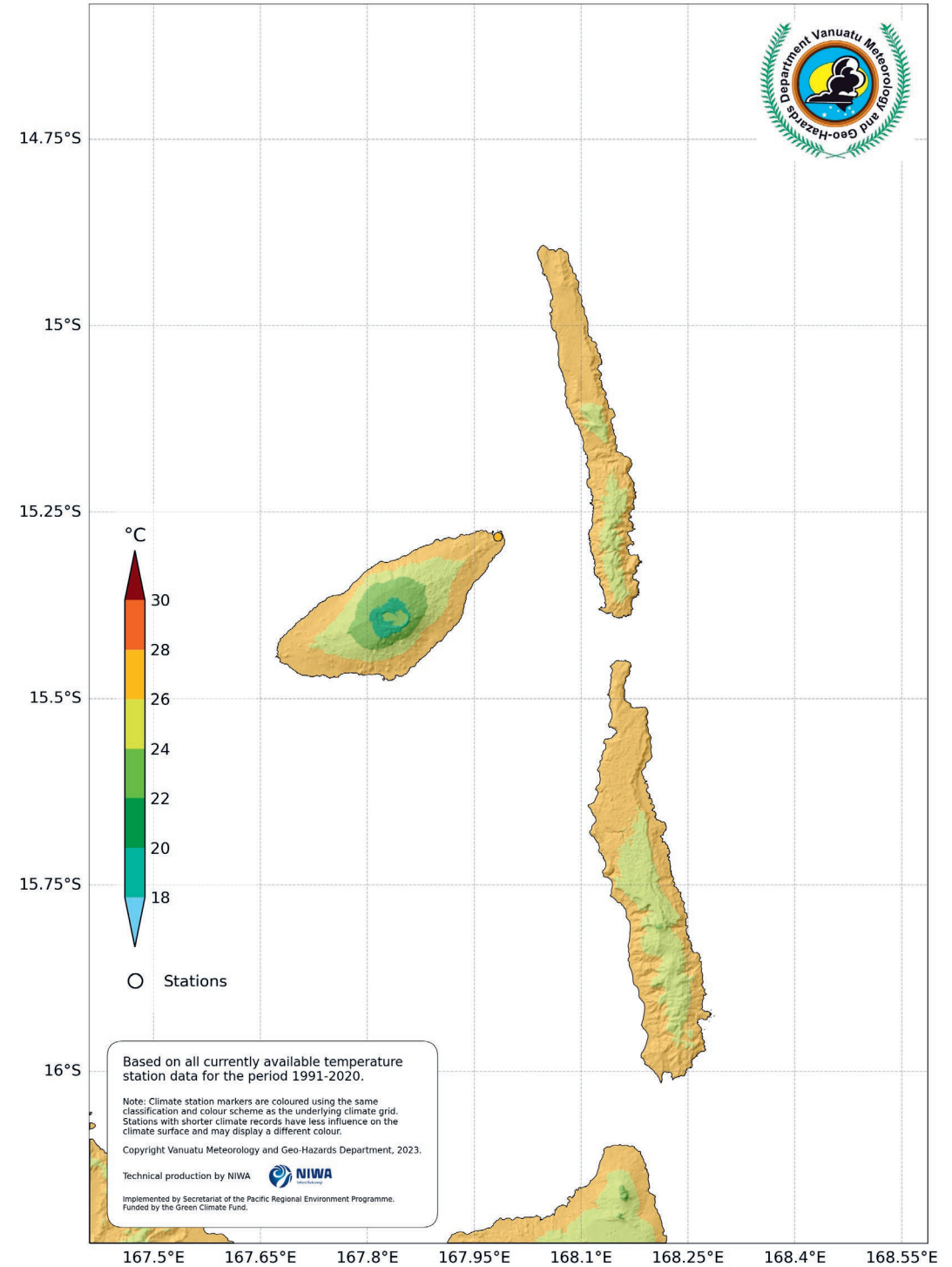

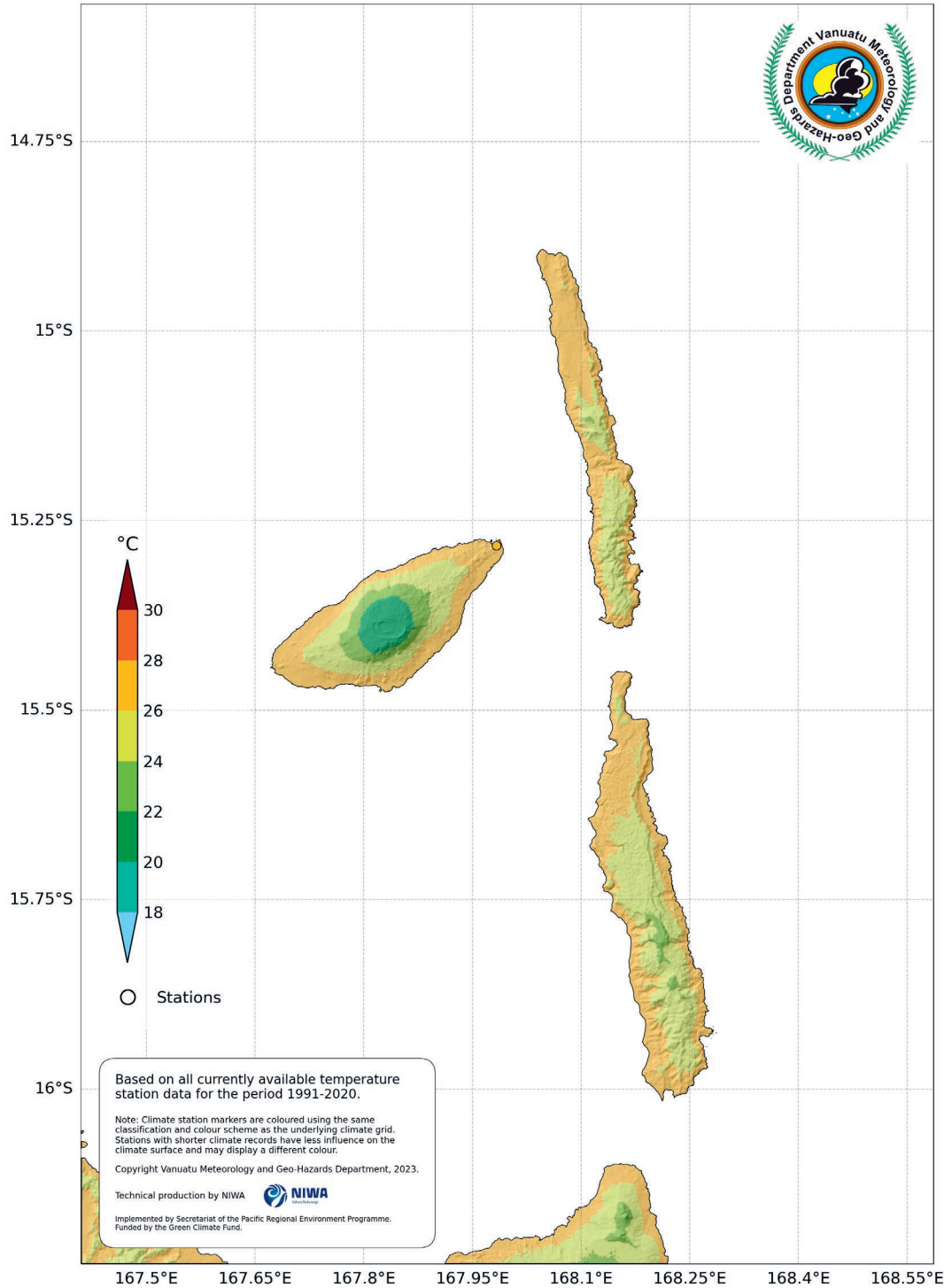

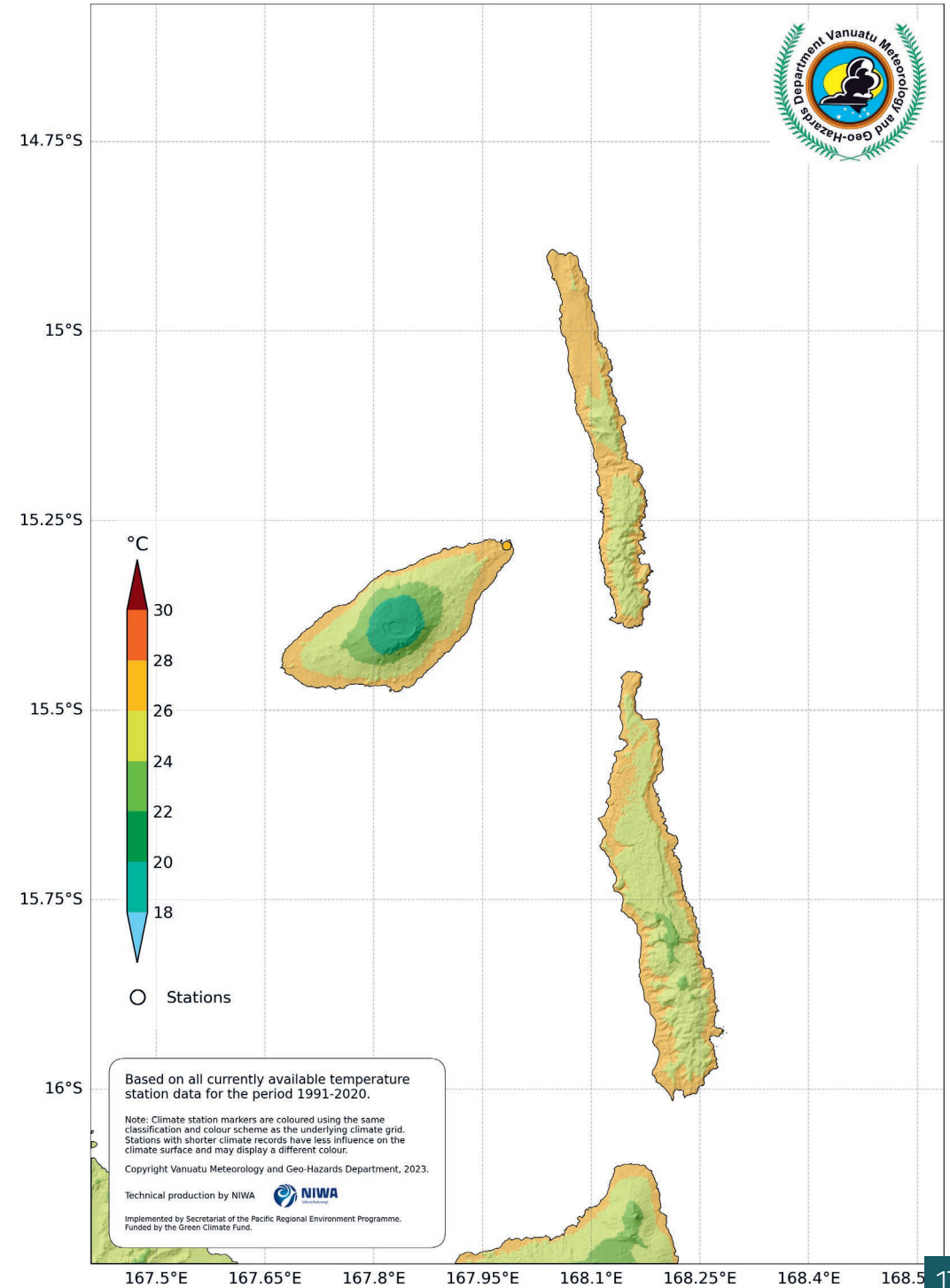

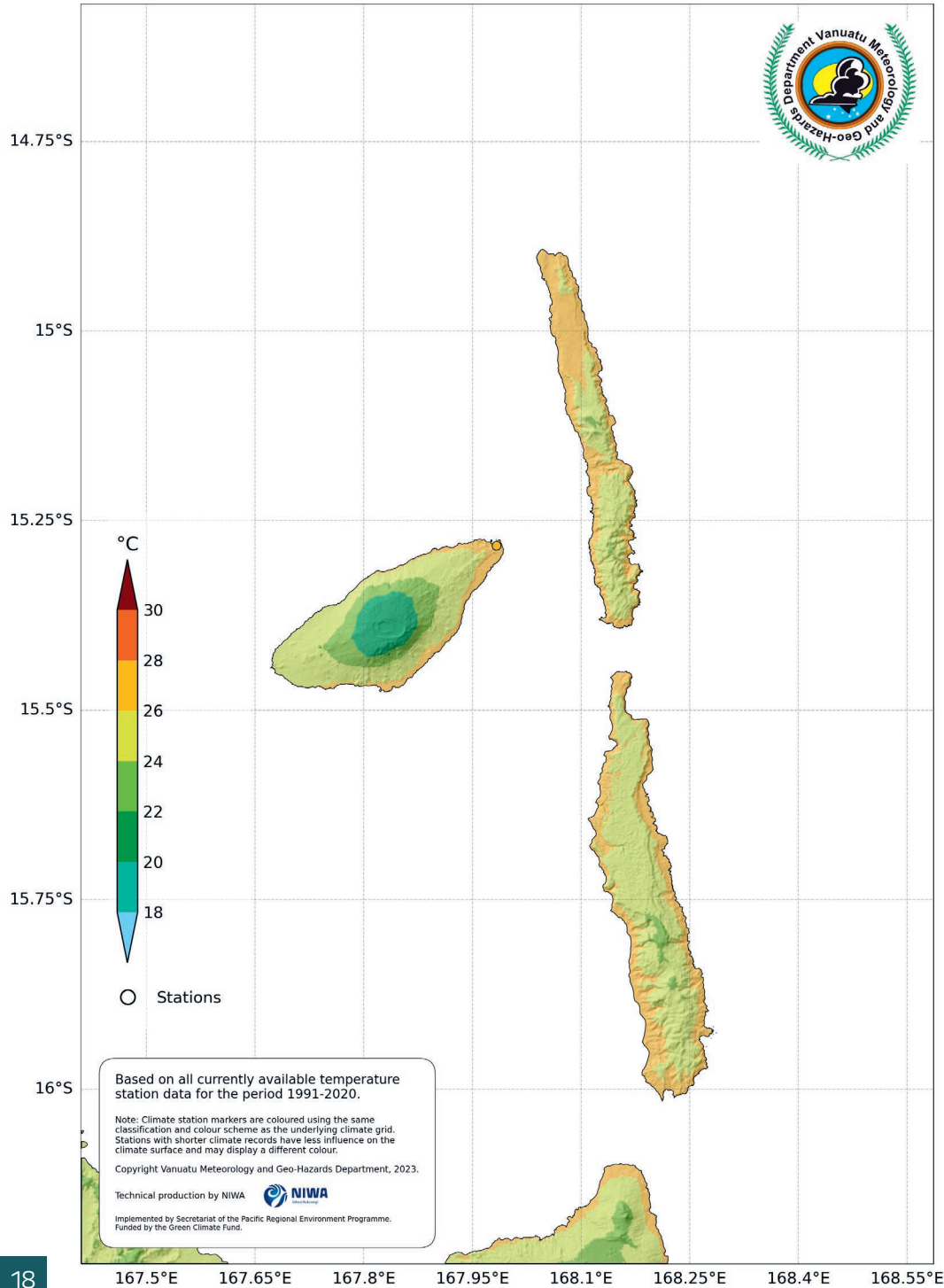
Penama: Mean April Temperature



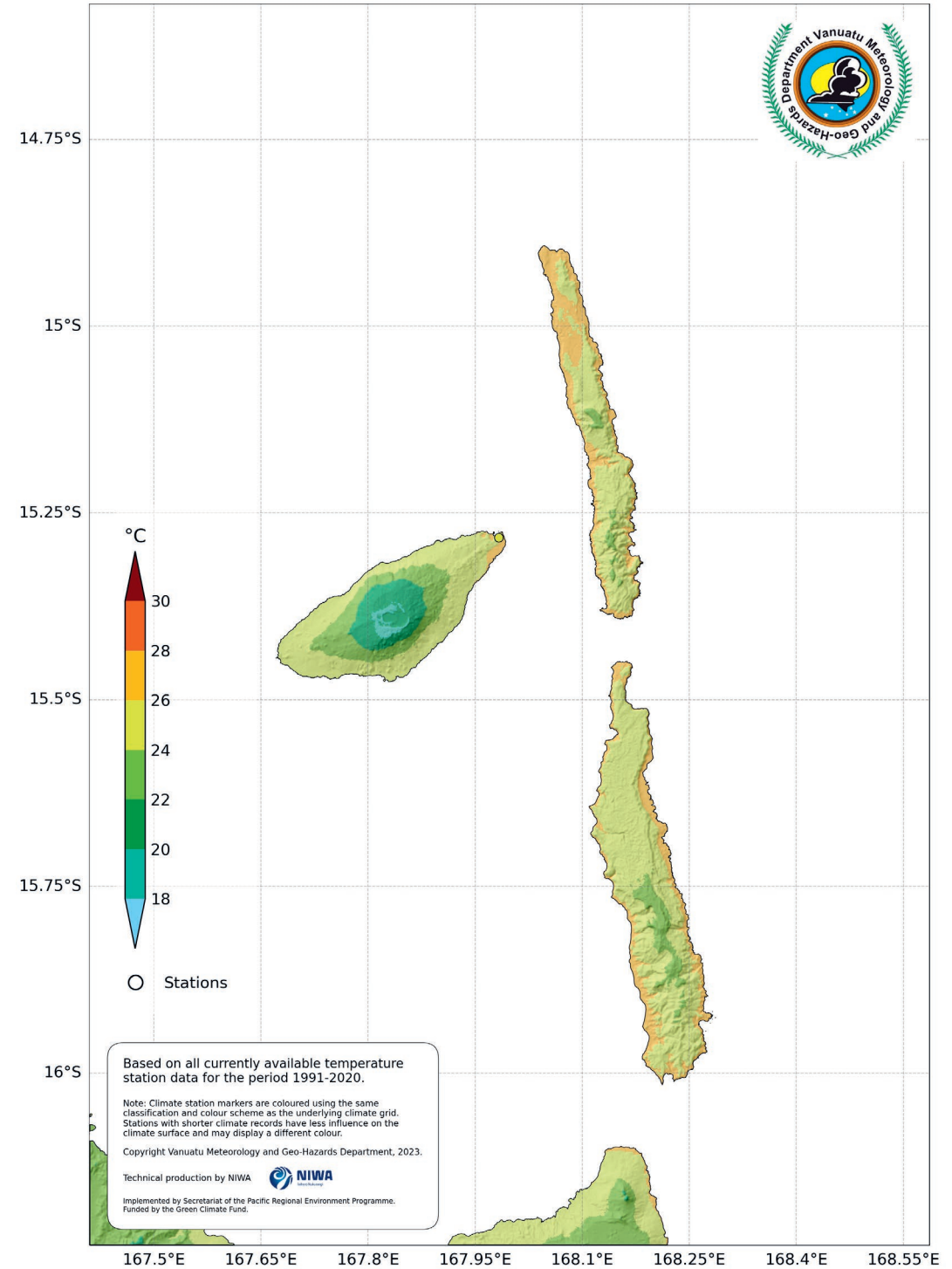

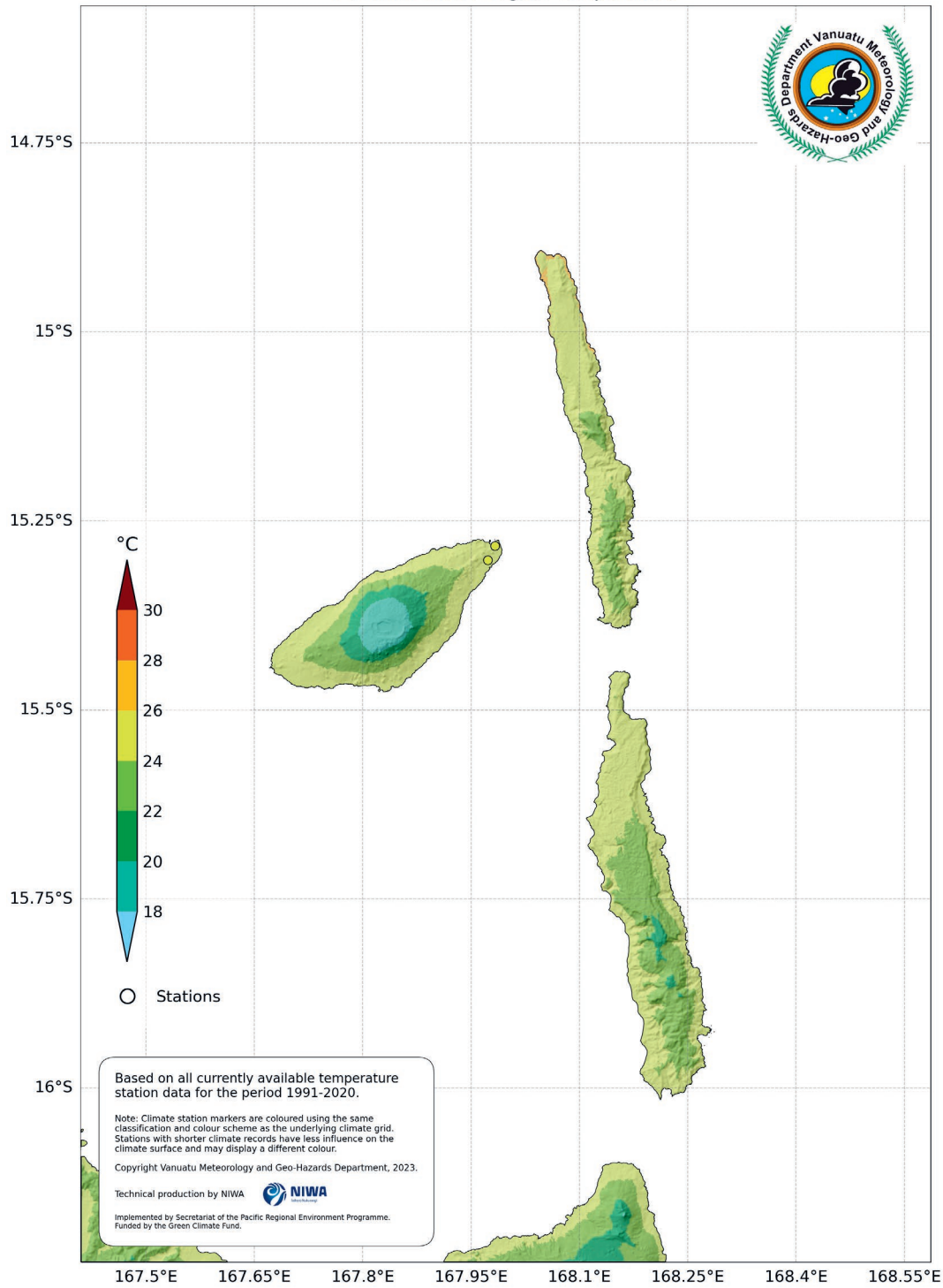

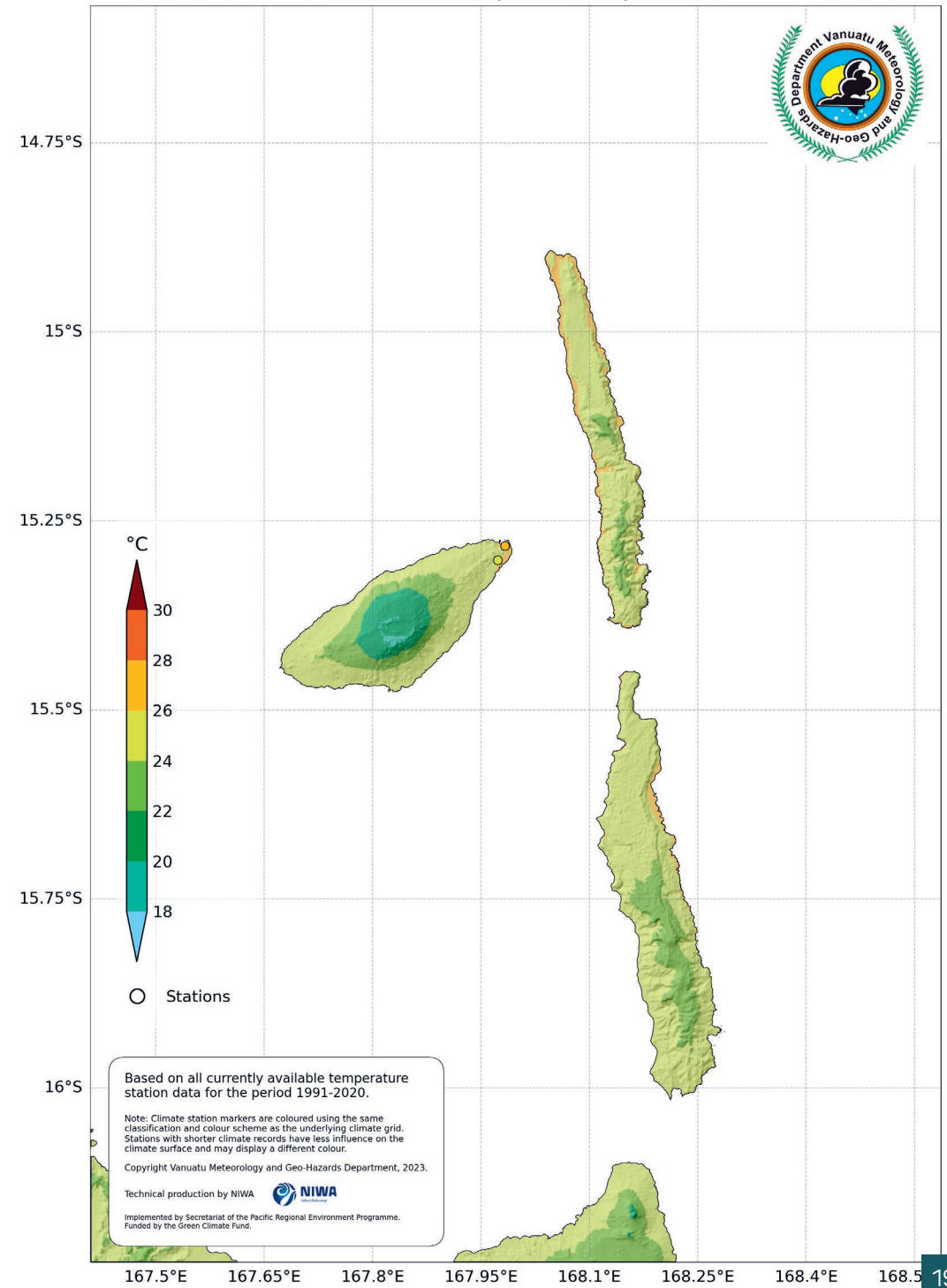




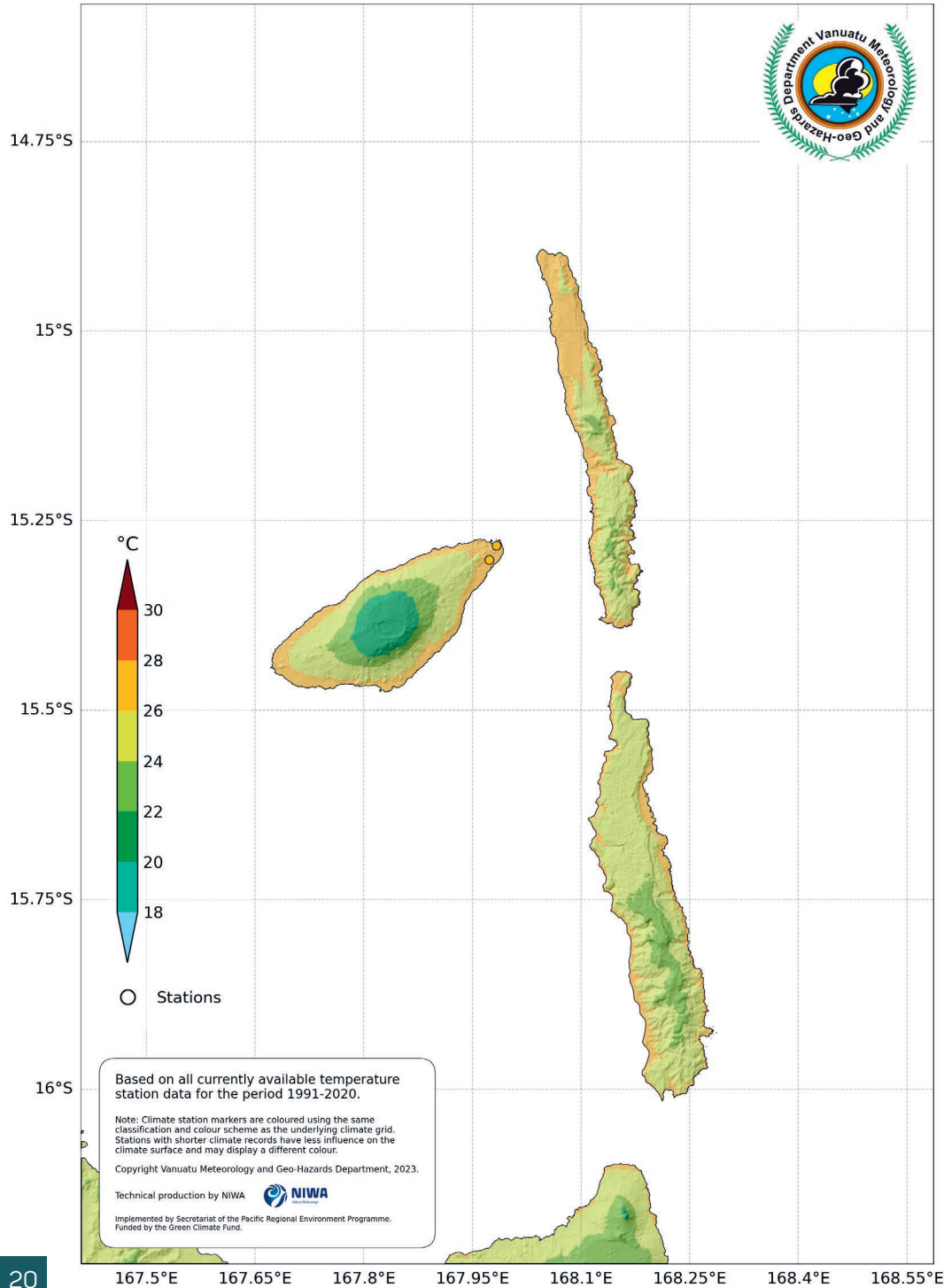

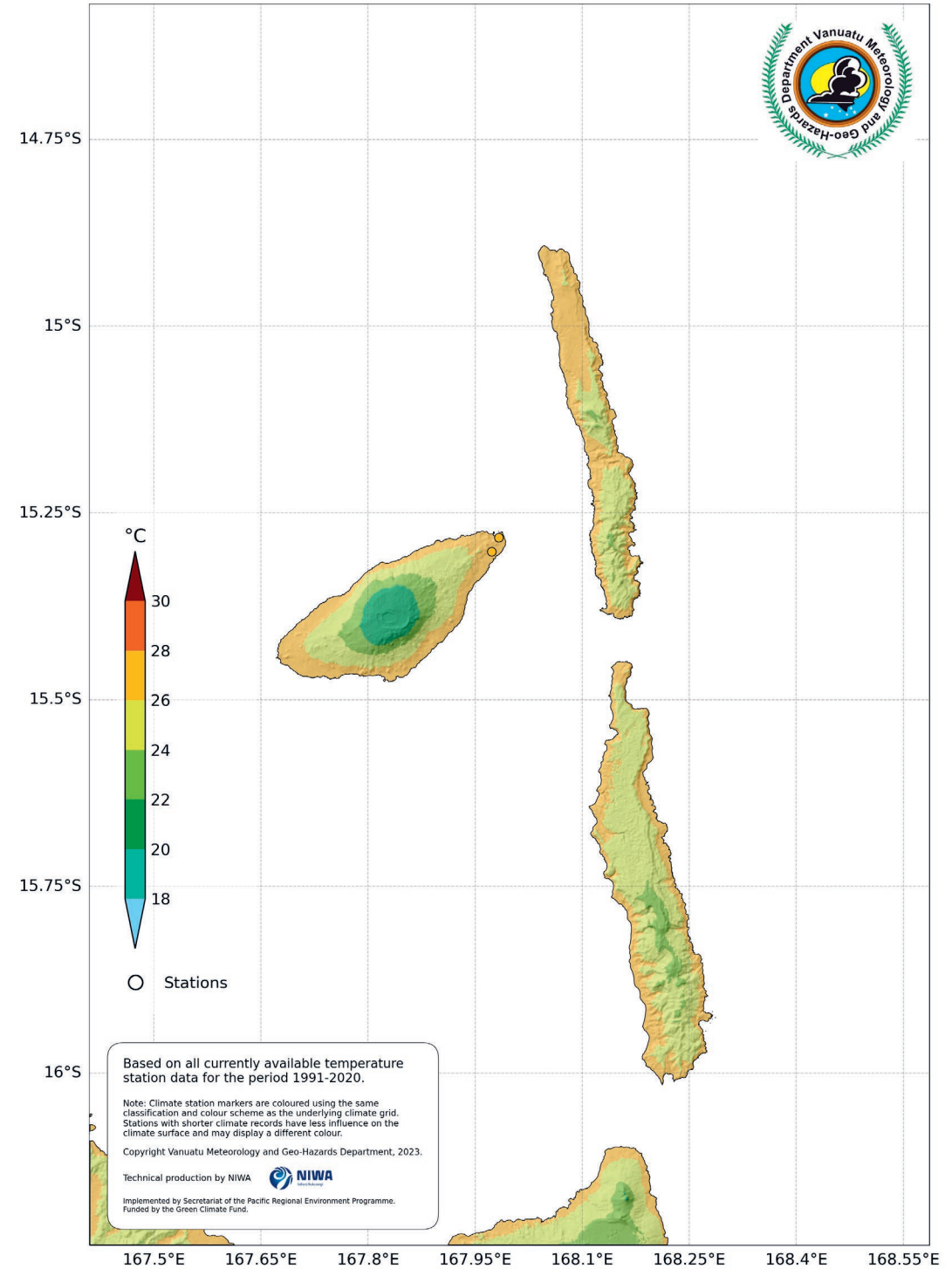

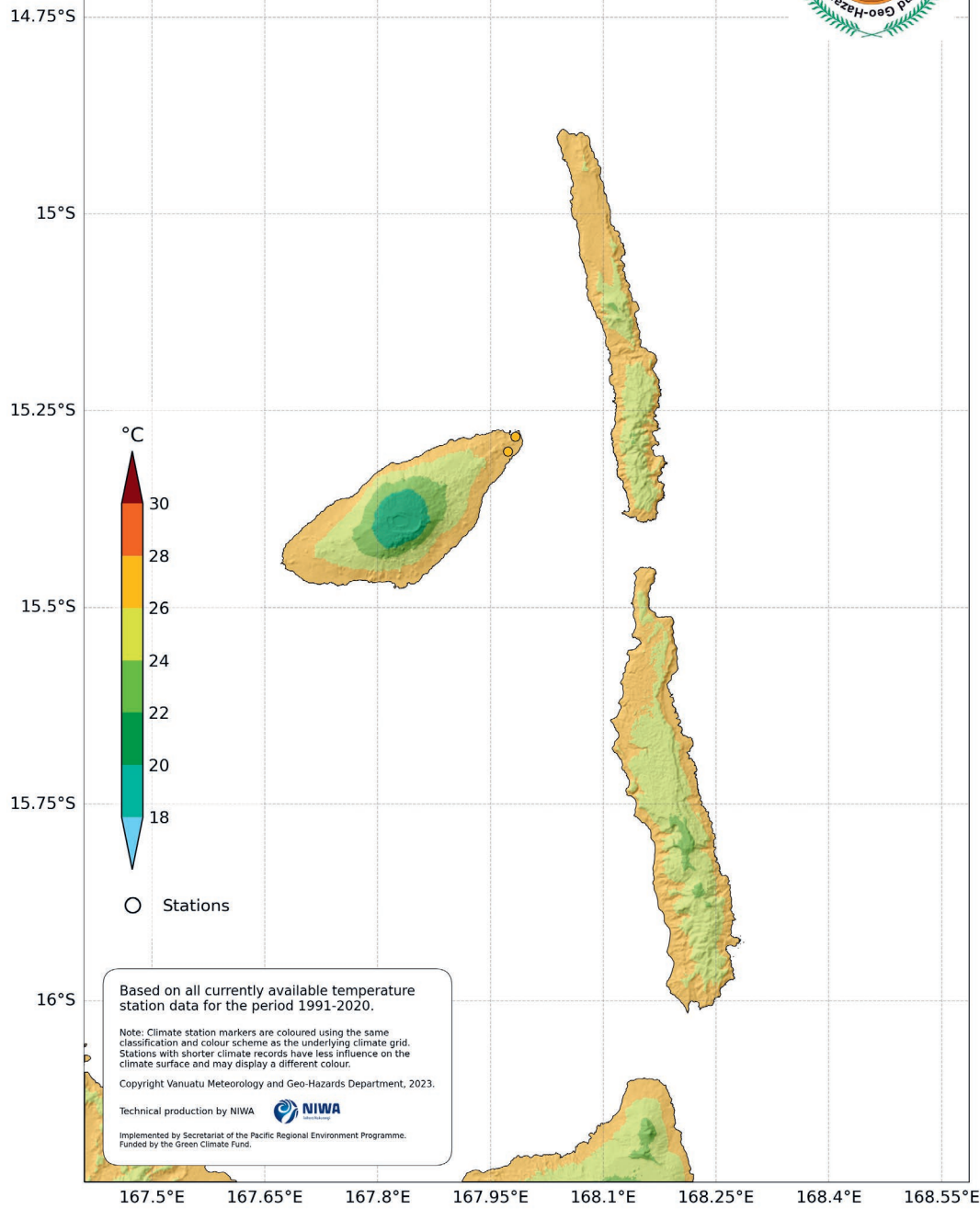
